By choosing Saint Joseph Catholic School for your children, you are providing a strong foundation on their path to becoming faithful Christian disciples and responsible, engaged citizens. The mark of a school's authentic Catholicity is found in the faithful witness of its teachers and administrators. With them lies the primary responsibility for creating and sustaining a truly Christian school climate—both individually and as a community. The educators and administrators of Saint Joseph Catholic School recognize that their example is essential to students' formation, as the daily witness of adults is a vital part of our school's identity and mission.

Enrollment for the 2026–2027 school year is now open for students in 3K through 8th grade. If you are interested in a school tour or would like to meet with members of our staff, please contact the school office, and we will be happy to schedule an appointment.

We are deeply grateful for the continued financial support of both Saint Andrew and Saint Joseph Parishes. Their commitment to investing in our school and our children allows us to operate using a Fair Share Commitment rather than a fixed tuition rate.

While a minimum pledge is not required, we ask that families prayerfully consider the many ways they are able to support our school. Personal payments may be arranged annually, bi-annually, or monthly, with the amount determined by each family based on their ability to contribute toward their child's education.

Families also have the option to apply for financial assistance through the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP). Open enrollment for this program begins February 2 and continues with designated enrollment periods each month through September 2026. A document explaining this program is attached for your review. Families who do not qualify for WPCP may still be eligible for scholarships made possible through the generosity of donors who are deeply invested in our school.

Financial constraints should never prevent a child from receiving a Catholic education. If you have questions or would like to discuss your family's situation privately, please contact the school office to arrange a meeting.
